The 15th edition of **W.A.VE. 2016** - **international workshop for architectural planning** - at IUAV University of Venice ended.

The "GFC course" worked for the creation of SEEDS, minimal architecture that takes form in strategical sites of Porto Marghera-Venezia and encourage the visitors to search new points of view to observe the future of a site with its past. Every Seed will be the epicenter of a new regeneration.

From the awareness of the economic, political and social issues that Italian territory, Europe, and even the world is going through, take off a new concept of urban regeneration and environmental requalification through the valorization of the pre-existences and the improvement of them with minimal operations.

The race to industrial production left us empty buildings; the race to consumerism left us empty souls; the race to development left us empty territories. From these realities come to life **seed #11** ("Scilla e Cariddi" a natural outpost between land and water), with the intention to restore the balance among community, territory, flora and fauna. A balance destroyed by the race to development, a balance that must be restored.
